Dear LDI research trainees and staff,

I have just sent Attestation forms to each PI at the LDI, that they will sign and send to you if you are a member of their team who must come to the LDI during the curfew. If you have to go to the LDI and your PI has not sent a signed form to you, please contact her/him directly.

IMPORTANT TO NOTE:

- 1. This exemption to the curfew is *ONLY* for those who need to go to the LDI and return to their homes from it.
- 2. The curfew exemption for LDI travel is *solely* for research and training purposes.
- You must carry this form with you at all times that you travel to and from the LDI during the curfew. The telephone number of your PI will be on the form that you receive. Be sure she/he has included their off-hours telephone number on the form you receive, in case the police etc. want to authenticate the validity of the form.
