Responsibilities include performing in-person assessments with long-term care residents, staff, and community members as part of research studies being conducted at our centre.

Duties, Responsibilities, and Requirements:

Under the direction of the Director and as part of research studies being conducted at our centre, the successful candidate will:

- Perform one-on-one in-person research assessments with vulnerable long-term care residents;
- Be present in the room during long-term care resident wound care procedures to conduct some of these research assessments;
