## About the Jewish General Hospital

The Jewish General Hospital (JGH) is one of Montréal's leading academic health centres and a McGill University-affiliated teaching hospital. Our Emergency Department is a high-volume, tertiary-care environment serving a diverse urban population, with a strong commitment to advancing emergency medicine through rigorous clinical research.

## Role Overview

We are seeking an outstanding investigator to lead and expand our research program. This individual will serve as the scientific anchor of the ED research program, driving a portfolio of high-impact studies, securing provincial and federal funding, and mentoring emergency physicians interested in research. This position holds a unique opportunity to shape the research culture of a dynamic department with institutional resources and support.

## Key Responsibilities

### Research Leadership

- Design, lead, and oversee clinical research projects within the Emergency Department.
- Develop and execute a coherent research agenda aligned with departmental and institutional priorities.
- Provide scientific mentorship to residents, fellows, and junior researchers.

### Grant Acquisition and Publication

- Lead preparation and submission of grant applications to provincial agencies (FRQS, FRQS-FRQ) and federal agencies (CIHR, CFI).
- Identify and pursue additional funding streams including foundation grants and industry partnerships.
- Track and report on grant milestones, deliverables, and renewals. Publish findings in peer-reviewed journals and present at national/international conferences.






## Collaboration & Partnership

- Collaborate with clinicians, administrators, and allied health professionals within and beyond the JGH.
- Build inter-institutional research networks at McGill University and partner hospitals.
- Engage with patient partners and community stakeholders to ensure research relevance and support knowledge translation.

- Demonstrated success in securing competitive peer-reviewed grant funding (provincial or federal).
- Experience managing and coordinating multi-faceted research projects.
- Exceptional communication and interpersonal skills for cross-disciplinary collaboration.

- Familiarity with emergency medicine or acute care research environments.
- Experience with qualitative and mixed-methods research designs.
- Bilingualism (English and French) is a requirement given our patient population.
- Prior experience supervising trainees or research personnel.
